THIS IS A USA SWIMMING OBSERVED MEET:

Please be sure to submit your USA Swimming IDs along with your entries via Hytek or email attachment.

Each team is allowed four swimmers per event; each contestant shall be limited to four events, no more than two of which may be individual events. Follow all rules of the current NFHS and FHSAA Swimming & Diving manuals.

Relays: Any swimmer, on the previously handed in team roster, may be eligible for a relay. Relay cards will be included in your coach's packet. Relay teams are to present completed card to the lane timer at the time of the swim. Relay athletes are to be listed left to right in the order that they will swim.

REMINDER: You MAY NOT scratch a swimmer from an individual event in order to swim an additional relay.

Scratches: There will be no declared false starts.

Timing System: Colorado Timing System provided by St. Petersburg Aquatics.

Timers: Each school is expected to provide TWO timers (must be registered volunteers) and donate a \$25 Gift card for volunteer officials.

Warm-Up Times: 6:45-7:15 group 1 and 7:15-7:45 group 2
Warmup lanes will be assigned after entries are submitted

Camera Zones: Per Florida Swimming Rule 223.12, Meet Management shall designate and inform the public of “Camera Zones” at each swim meet where both still photography and video photography of a race or a competitor in a race may be taken. Acceptable “Camera Zones” may include, but are not limited to the side courses of a pool, team gathering areas, concession area, turn-end of competition course when not in use as a “start-end”, etc. Meet Management shall also designate “Non-Camera Zones”. Under NO circumstances will Camera Zones include the area immediately behind the starting blocks at either end of the racing course(s) while they are in use for “race starting purposes” during competition and warm-ups, locker rooms, restrooms, or any other dressing area. Any individual failing to abide by this rule could be subject to the Florida Swimming Code of Conduct violation as defined in Rule.

Special Notes: ONLY PARENTS THAT ARE WORKING THE MEET ARE ALLOWED ON THE POOL DECK.

Hospitality will provide meals and snacks for coaches and officials.

- Facilities:** 12.5 ft diving well with two 1-meter Duraflex boards
- Warm-ups:** 4:30 PM Warmups
5:30 PM FINAL dive sheet due, no corrections after 5:30 PM
- Competition:** 6:00 PM Diving competition begins
Boys and Girls will be Diving together during the competition
- Diving Sheets:** Divers must be listed on the school's Master Entry Form; a rough draft dive sheet should be submitted to Bill Walker(whw@walkeratty.com). Dive sheets must include 11 dives, including 5 voluntary dives clearly marked and 6 optional dives representing all 5 dive groups. Dive sheets must be submitted no later than noon on Tuesday, October 1st . Each contestant should submit two signed diving score sheets as a PDF or Word Doc, (ABSOLUTELY NO PICTURES will be accepted), indicate on email, voluntary dives by using bold graphics or highlighting these dives, sheet will include the following:
1. Dive number
 2. Written description
 3. Position
 4. Degree of difficulty
 5. Order in which dives will be attempted
- Order of Completion:** Preliminary Round: 2 voluntary dives and 3 optional dives
Semi-final Round: 2 voluntary dives and 1 optional dive
Final Round: 1 voluntary dive and 2 optional dives

NOTE: Each optional dive MUST represent ALL 5 diving categories; no minimum total degree of difficulty for optional dives for entry into the meet; degree of difficulty for all dives listed in the NFHS Rules book.

- Diving Judges:** Diving Judges will be selected by Bill Walker of those who wish to judge.

- Spectator Fee:** \$5.00 entry fee for diving spectators, Spectators will be separate from the Divers.
