- DECK CHANGING & SHAVING:** Changing on deck & shaving on the premises is PROHIBITED by FHSAA rule. Competitors use only the individual restrooms on the side of the main building.

- Type of Meet: 25-yard Short Course High School District Championship Timed Final format.  
Meet Management may opt to use fly-over starts at this competition.
- Pool Specs: Certified 25 -yard outdoor pool with a maximum of two eight lane racing courses, having a minimum depth of 5 feet and non-turbulent lane lines.  
(Backstroke Ledges are not permitted in High School Swimming.)
- Timing System: Electronic Timing System with scoreboard, manual back-up watches-Computer Scoring
- Gate Fee: \$8.00 per person/per session. Purchase tickets at GoFan.co
- Host: Osceola Fundamental High School
- Administrator in Charge: Cynthia Mucerino , Athletic Director
- Eligibility: All swimmers submitted on each team’s District Meet entry list (per Home Campus)
- Warm up: Assignments will be made once entries are submitted.

Seeding: Timed finals slowest to fastest using 8 lanes

Scoring: Individual: 20, 17,16,15,14,13,12,11,9,7,6,5,4,3,2,1  
Relay: 40, 34,32,30,28,26,24,22,18,14,12,10,8,6,4,2

Awards: Girls Team Champion and runner up, Boys Team Champion and runner up  
Ribbons 1<sup>st</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> both individual and relay events

Entries: All entries with times (Hy-tek file) must be submitted via email by Wednesday, October 16, 2024 by Noon to: John Ware at [johnware@midnightsports.com](mailto:johnware@midnightsports.com) . If you are having any difficulties submitting your entries, please contact John at #813-240-3893. Entries failing to make the deadline may result in not being entered in the meet. Follow all FHSAA protocols for official entries. Relay cards will be provided at the meet.

A student athlete whose name was not originally submitted on the official entry list is not eligible to participate in the district meet until the additional of his or her name is approved by the FHSAA office.

Each team is allowed a maximum of 4 swimmers per event; each contestant shall be limited to a maximum of 4 events, no more than two of which may be individual events. Follow all rules of the 2024-2025 NFHS rules book and the FHSAA Swimming & Diving Manual.

Swimmers must have their USA swimming numbers in the entry file for times to be recognized by USA Swimming.

Relays: Any swimmer on your Master Entry form (HyTek file) may be eligible for a relay. Prior to the start of the relay events, you must turn in your relay card listing your relay swimmers. Relay card must also designate the name of the lead-off swimmer who actually swims in the lead-off position. You may list up to 8 swimmers. Reminder: You MAY NOT scratch a swimmer from an individual event in order to swim an additional relay.

Declared False Start: During the Florida High School State Championship Series, NO declared false starts are permitted.

Failure to Compete: A competitor who fails to compete (no show) in an event in which he/she has officially entered, shall be disqualified from further competition in the state series unless the failure to compete is due to a medical reason certified by an appropriate medical professional and declared to the Meet Referee in advance of the event.

Notes: Entry Fee: Each team is to pay \$150 entry fee as agreed upon in the district meeting. Please send a check to Osceola Fundamental High School, attention to Michelle Smith, by 10/21 or your team could be withheld from participation, per FHSAA policy.

2024 District Shirts: FHSAA approved vendor will be on site to sell district t-shirts.

Deck Passes: Only Athletes, Coaches, Volunteers will be allowed on deck. Any School Photographers must have prior approval to be on deck, just like Timer Volunteers. Wristbands will be issued.

Coaches Info: One coach and one captain per team will meet at 9:10 am on the pool deck.

Concessions: Concessions and hospitality will be very limited based on local rules and protocols.

Timers: Each team should provide two timers for the session.

All timers should be registered volunteers with the school system in their county.

Club Coaches: Club coaches may sit at the turn end of the pool on deck at the warm up/warm down end of the pool.

Camera Zones: Per FHSAA, meet management shall designate and inform the public of 'Camera Zones' at each meet where both still photography and video photography of a race or competitor in a race may be taken. Acceptable 'Camera Zones' may include but are not limited to the side course of a pool, team gathering areas, concession area, and turn-end of the pool when not in use as the start end. Meet management shall also designate 'No Camera Zones'. Under NO circumstances will camera zones include the area immediately behind the starting blocks at either end of the racing course while they are in use for 'race starting purposes' during competition and warm up. No camera zones also include locker rooms, restrooms, or any other dressing area.

**Any individual failing to abide by this rule could be subject to the FHSAA Code of Conduct violation.**

Boys and Girls may run concurrently. Diving referees will have the discretion to make any necessary changes in compliance of the rules to permit and ensure safe and continual competition.

Dive Sheets: All divers must be listed on Master Entry Form (via Home Campus) and in the Hy-tek file submitted to John Ware on or before the October 16<sup>th</sup> deadline.

Please bring your dive sheet already filled out day of meet at 4pm to give to Karen Smalley. Changes can be made until 4:40pm.

A Coach or HS Representative should be present at the competition to sign dive sheets.

The following must be included on each sheet:

1. Dive Number
2. Written Description
3. Position
4. Degree of Difficulty
5. Order in which dives will be attempted

Order of Competition:

Preliminary Round:	2 voluntary dives and 3 optional dives
Semi-Final Round:	2 voluntary dives and 1 optional dive
Final Round:	1 voluntary dive and 2 optional dives

Note: Each listed optional dive must represent all five diving categories; All divers must meet NFHS standards and regulations in addition to the FHSAA Swimming & Diving Manual.
