**Scoring:** Individual: 20,17,16, 15,14,13,12,11,9,7,6,5,4,3,2,1  
Relays: 40,34,32,30,28,26,24,22,18,14,12,10,8,6,4,2

**Awards:** Girls team champion and runner-up and boys team champion and runner-up.

- Entries:** Swimmers that qualified in their respective District Meets and were listed on the Region Meet psych sheet are eligible to participate. A student-athlete whose name was not originally submitted on the official entry list is not eligible to participate in the Region meet until the addition of his or her name is approved by the FHSAA office.  
Each team is allowed four swimmers per event; each contestant shall be limited to four events, no more than two of which may be individual events. Follow all rules of the 2022-23NFHS Rules Book and the 2022 FHSAA Swimming & Diving Manual.
- Relays:** Any swimmer on your Master Entry Form (SW3) may be eligible for a relay. Relay cards will be provided in the morning coaches meeting. Prior to the start of the relay events, you must turn in your relay card listing your relay swimmers. You may list up to eight swimmers. **REMINDER: You MAY NOT scratch a swimmer from an individual event in order to swim an additional relay.**
- Scratches:** There will be no declared false starts.

- Warm-Up Lanes:** Two warm-up sessions - Lanes will be assigned by Wednesday, November 6

- Notes:** Any financial losses will be divided equally among participating schools.

- Diving Judges:** Each team should have a coach available to judge and names should be submitted to Kathie McNeil ([coachkathiediving@gmail.com](mailto:coachkathiediving@gmail.com)) by no later than 12 pm on Monday, November 4
- Dive Sheets:** All divers must have qualified in their respective District Meets and listed on the Region Meet psych sheet.  
**Please send a dive list to Kathie McNeil ([coachkathiediving@gmail.com](mailto:coachkathiediving@gmail.com)) by no later than 12 pm on Monday, November 4.** Please indicate voluntary dives with a "V" or highlight.  
**This list may be adjusted until 4:00 pm on the day of the meet.**  
A Coach or high school representative should be present to sign sheets, which will be at the scoring table upon your arrival.
- Order of Competition:** Preliminary round: 2 voluntary dives & 3 optional dives  
Semi-final round: 2 voluntary dives & 1 optional dive  
Final round: 1 voluntary dive & 2 optional dives  
  
All five groups must be represented in the first 8 rounds.  
  
The first 8 rounds must not have 2 optionals from a single group.
- Note:** **All divers and lists must meet 2024-25 NFHS standards and regulations in addition to the 2024 FHSAA Swimming & Diving Manual.**
