APPROVAL

Held under the approval of USA Swimming through Florida Swimming: #FL-A-7280

It is understood and agreed that USA Swimming, Florida Swimming and Carrollwood Village Swim Team, shall be free from any liabilities or claims for damages arising by reason of injuries to anyone during the conduct of the event.

1. Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member-coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water without the use of the backstroke ledge. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.
2. Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, restrooms or locker rooms.
3. Deck changes are prohibited.
4. Operation of a drone or any other flying devices is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.

Exceptions may be granted with prior written approval by the Program & Events Coordinator (or his/her designee).

5. All adults participating in or associated with this meet acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with MAAPP is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.
6. The meet host will ensure that the competition course meets the required dimensions as specified in 103.3 USA Swimming Rules and Regulations.

TYPE OF MEET	<p>Twenty-five (25) yard course</p> <p>All Relays, 8&U events, 1650 Free, and Friday events are timed finals.</p> <p>All Saturday and Sunday events for 10&U will be swum as prelims and finals. (No consolation finals)</p> <p>All Saturday and Sunday events for 11-12 and older will be swum as prelims, consolation finals, and finals. Finals will be run <u>before</u> consolation finals in each event.</p> <p>The meet will be run in two courses if necessary, and relays will begin on each course without delay as listed on the attached order of events. <u>All timed final events on Friday and the 1650 Freestyles will run fastest to slowest.</u></p> <p>Events of 200 yards or greater have qualifying times as noted in the order of events.</p> <p>Swimmers not having achieved the qualifying time in an event prior to the entry deadline for the meet will not be allowed to swim in that event.</p>
DATE AND TIME	<p>Friday April 10 - Timed finals start at 5 PM. Saturday April 11, and Sunday April 12 - Prelims start at 9:00 AM each day. Finals start at 5 PM.</p>
LOCATION	North Shore Aquatic Complex, 901 North Shore Drive NE, St. Petersburg, Florida 33701. (727) 893-7727
POOL SPECS	Certified outdoor 22-lane facility. The meet may be run in two courses, up to 10 lanes in each course. Finals will be in one 10-lane course. The water depth at the competition starting & turn ends is a minimum of 4 feet.
MEDICAL	Lifeguards on duty and AED device available.
TIMING EQUIPMENT	Automatic Timing System plus computer scoring.
WARM-UP	<p>Continuous warm-up/down will be provided. Competition Pool Warm-up: Friday: 3:30 PM - 4:50 PM Saturday & Sunday: Prelims 7:30-8:50AM, Finals 3:30-4:50 PM</p>
WARM-UP PROCEDURE	<p>Coaches will run warm-ups in accord with USA Swimming rules. No equipment is permitted during warm-up. Entry to the pool must be executed feet first, with one hand on deck, except when executing coach supervised racing starts. There will be assigned lanes for warm-up based on team entries, and lane assignments will be posted on the meet's web page on CVST.org and at the meet. <u>Coach supervised racing starts may only be executed in one-way racing lanes.</u></p>
ELIGIBILITY	<p>Open to CVST & Boys & Girls Club members. The meet will be limited to the first 700 swimmers, and will be closed with the receipt of the teams' entry that puts the meet entries at or over 700. Late entry packets may not be admitted to the meet. This is a USA Swimming "approved" meet, where non-USA Swimming registered swimmers may enter. USA Swimming rules apply to <u>all</u> swimmers, and the times achieved by USA Swimming registered swimmers are recognized. In events with qualifying times, the swimmer may only swim if he/she achieved the qualifying time or better before the entry deadline. Swimmers not having achieved the qualifying time in an event before the entry deadline will not be allowed to swim in that event. <i>If a swimmer does not meet the qualifying time for an event swum at the meet, in either Prelims or Finals, the awards and points will not be awarded for that swim. Furthermore, proof of a previously swum qualifying time may be required to be provided to the Clerk of Course within 30 minutes of the swim and prior to that swimmers next event or a \$15.00 fine may be levied before that swimmer will be permitted to swim their next event in the meet. These fines must be paid to the Clerk of Course. Individual Team's will be responsible for all outstanding fines. Before being permitted to enter any future Boys & Girls Club National Championship Meets all fines must be paid.</i></p>



Each USA Swimming team must submit a Master Entry form verifying certified teams & coaches. No swimmer will be allowed to participate without being duly entered on the appropriate entry form submitted at the time of entry. Each team must also provide their representation as of January 1, 2026.

Relays: Relay swimmers must be the age group of the relay being swum. Swimmers are not allowed to swim up or down an age group. Any age swimmers may swim in the Senior Relays. All Relay swimmers **MUST** be listed on the Master Entry Form.

SEEDING

Twenty-five-yard times will be used for seeding purposes.

ENTRY LIMIT

Each swimmer may enter and swim a maximum of three (3) events per day, plus relays. Individuals over-entered will be considered entered in the first three events of that day. Each team may enter a maximum of three relays per relay event.

ENTRY FORMS

Entries **MUST** be submitted on the enclosed entry form, which also serves as proof of entry. Current USA Swimming numbers **MUST BE LISTED** for USA Swimming registered swimmers. Those swimmers who are not USA Swimming registered must be designated as such. All swimmers must have an age noted and either a USA Swimming number or birth date indicated. The Executive Director of each Boys and Girls Club must sign this form indicating that all swimmers are Boys & Girls Club members. For USA Swimming Clubs, A non-athlete member of USA Swimming must sign the forms. **NOTE:** USA Swimming SDIF or Hy-Tek CL2 Disks will be

accepted with a printed hard copy in place of the individual entry sheets. The Master Entry Sheet is still required. **Teams not using a Hy-Tek .cl2 file and Hy-Tek Meet Entries Report will be charged a \$50.00 Team Entry Fee.**

ENTRY FEES

\$20.00 per swimmer facility charge; \$8.50 per individual event / \$10.00 per relay; \$2.00 Florida Swimming out of State swimmer fee; \$50.00 team entry fee if not using SDIF or CL2 files for entry. **\$3 PER SWIMMER HEAT SHEET SURCHARGE**

SCRATCHES

Preliminaries and Timed Finals: No penalty for scratching.

500, 1650 Free & 400 IM: Any swimmer entered in the any of these events, and who has checked in for that event, must swim. Failure to do so will result in being barred from the next individual event that he/she is entered. The deadlines for positive check in for these events are listed in the Order of Events.

Finals and Consolation Finals: Any swimmer who competes in a preliminary heat and qualifies for a final or consolation final (Top 20 swimmers only), and fails to notify the Clerk of Course that they will scratch, within 30 minutes of his/her last individual preliminary event of the day, and fails to swim that event, will be barred from the next individual event in which the swimmer is scheduled to swim. The only exception will be that, in the case of injury or illness, and upon certification of such by the meet referee, no penalty will be declared.

ALTERNATES

Alternates wishing to swim in an open lane in the consolation finals of any event, or the finals of 10-Under events, must report to the Starter and be standing, ready to step on the blocks, at the starters stand by the start of the race. No swimmers will be called from the stands to swim.

DECK ENTRIES

Deck entries will be accepted by the Administrative Referee in timed finals or prelim events, including relays, provided that no new heats are created, that the swimmer does not exceed the permitted number of events, and that the swimmer must meet the same qualifications as the other swimmers in the meet. A swimmer may not scratch or fail to appear in an event in order to deck enter another event. The fee will be \$10.00 per event plus the \$20.00 Facility Fee if applicable and the \$2.00 out of State Swimmer Fee if



applicable, payable immediately. Any deck-seeded entries must be approved by the Administrative Referee a minimum of 30 minutes before the start of the session the event will be swum.

- ENTRY DEADLINE** **Entries, fees and all forms must be received by 6:00 PM Friday, April 3, 2026.** Please mail via Express Mail or other rapid mail service. Faxed entries are not acceptable. E-mail entries will be accepted at Jen@CVST.org, as long as the entry fees are received by the posted entry deadline. Teams will be accepted in the order received. Make checks payable to CVST.
- AWARDS** Individual Events: 1st-10th Special Awards
Relays 1st-3rd Special Awards
Team: 1st-3rd Special Awards
Individual High Point 1st-3rd in each age group Special Awards
Special Team Spirit Award (Host Club ineligible for Spirit Award)
- SCORING** Individual finals: consolation finals and timed finals: 24-21-20-19-18-17-16-15-14-13-11-9-8-7-6-5-4-3-2-1. Relays score double.
- RULES** Current USA Swimming rules will govern the meet.
- CAMERA ZONES** Per Florida Swimming Rule 223.13, Meet Management shall designate and inform the public of "Camera Zones" at each swim meet where both still photography and video photography of a race or a competitor in a race may be taken. Acceptable "Camera Zones" may include, but are not limited to the side courses of a pool, team gathering areas, concession area, turn-end of competition course when not in use as a "start-end," etc. Meet Management shall also designate "Non-Camera Zones." Under NO circumstances will Camera Zones include the area immediately behind the starting blocks at either end of the racing course(s) while they are in use for "race starting purposes" during competition and warm-ups, locker rooms, restrooms, or any other dressing area. Any individual failing to abide by this rule could be subject to the Florida Swimming Code of Conduct violation as defined in Rule 239.2.
- HEAT SHEETS** Posted at www.CVST.org , www.midnightsports.com, no later than 48 hours prior to the start of the meet. These are to be printed and brought to the meet. A \$3 charge will be applied to each swimmer's entry fee. Coach, please email all swimmers and parents to make them aware of this.
- TEAM REP.** Prior to the start of the meet, each team may give the name of one other person other than the coach to the Meet Referee. The Meet Referee will recognize only the coach and the person so designated as the representatives of the team.
- TIMERS** Each team is required to provide timers during the meet. Assignments will be posted on the Meet Web page on www.CVST.org once all entries are received.

There will be a 10-minute break before the 1650s. 1650s will be swum in the West (Locker-Room) Course. That course may end before the East (Bayside) Course for the younger swimmers. **Do not enter younger swimmers in these events unless you are willing to risk the swimmer being called to swim at both ends at the same time.** The Meet Referee may move heats to the East (Bayside) Course when it finishes. These will be deck-seeded events; positive check in is required in order to be seeded. The positive check in deadline for the 1650 Free is 10:00am. Any swimmer entered in events 86-89 who fails to check in, but desires to swim may do so if there is an open lane, however no new heats will be created. Events 86&88 and 87&89 will be swum combined and scored separately. Heats will be seeded by entry times, regardless of age, with a maximum of 40 swimmers allowed for each event. Heats will be swum fastest to slowest and alternate girls and boys. Swimmers in events 86-89 must provide their own timers and counters.

Boys and Girls Clubs National Swimming Championships

Code of Conduct

Introduction:

This event is held under the joint auspices of the Boys and Girls Clubs of America and USA Swimming. The participants, officials, coaches, and parents attending are expected to conduct themselves within the rules and expectations of these two organizations. Below we will outline the guidelines that must be adhered to at this event. This is not meant to be an exhaustive list, but a description of the general behaviors expected.

Expectations:

The Boys & Girls Clubs enforce the following four codes of conduct:

- ❑ Respect for all persons and property.
- ❑ Respect for facilities and equipment.
- ❑ Respect for all staff, volunteers, and officials.
- ❑ The following are strictly prohibited:
 - Cursing, swearing, racial remarks or any other form of verbal abuse.
 - Fighting or any other form of physical abuse.
 - Use or possession of controlled substances, weapons, and intoxicants.
 - Smoking, chewing, or any other use of tobacco products.
 - Music containing inappropriate or suggestive language.
 - Photography outside the officially designated Camera Zones.
 - Changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or other designated areas is prohibited.

USA Swimming has the following among its rules:

304.3.12 It is a violation of the USA Swimming Code of Conduct if there is any non-consensual physical contact, obscene language or gesture, or other threatening language or conduct directed towards any meet official and which is related to any decision made by such official in connection with a USA Swimming competition.

304.2.15 Any other act, conduct or omission which is detrimental to the image or reputation of USA Swimming or the sport of swimming.

Authority

The Meet Referee has the authority to enforce the above, as stated by rules of USA Swimming as follows

102.13.1 The Referee shall have full authority over all officials...shall enforce all applicable rules and shall decide all questions relating to the actual conduct of the meet, the final settlement of which is not otherwise assigned by said rules...shall also disqualify a swimmer for any violation of the rules...

In addition, Florida Swimming, who approves this meet, has the following rule:

239.2 Any individual (parent, coach, swimmer, official, or spectator) displaying unsportsmanlike conduct will first be warned to cease such conduct and if the behavior continues the Referee or meet management will eject the individual from the facility.

Let's have respect for others so that all of us will have a great meet!

Critical Information

1. Coaches: **Please print legibly** on the entry forms! Hytek entries submitted on disk are requested. Remember to observe the entry limits (3 events/day) and remember that: *If a swimmer does not meet the qualifying time for an event swum at the meet, proof of the previously swum qualifying time may be required to be provided to the Clerk of Course within 30 minutes of the swim and prior to that swimmers next event or a \$15.00 fine may be required to be paid before the swimmer will be permitted to swim their next event in the meet. Awards and points will not be awarded for a swim that is not faster than the qualifying time and is not proved within 30 minutes. These fines must be paid to the Clerk of Course. Team's will be responsible for all outstanding fines. Before being permitted to enter any future Boys & Girls Club National Championship Meets Teams MUST settle all fines.*
2. The 10&Under Age Group Finals will include the top 10 swimmers from preliminaries. 11&Over Finals will include the top 20 swimmers from preliminaries. Special Awards are now awarded to the top 20 swimmers in individual events and the top 10 teams in relay events.
3. Individual High Point Awards are awarded to the top 5 individuals in each age group.
4. As you know, the location of the meet this year will be the Northshore Aquatic Complex. The Complex has a large bleacher area for spectators, although it will not hold all spectators and swimmers. As this is the best area for spectator viewing of the meet, and swimmers have deck seating at the East (Bay) end of the pool, **NO swimmers will be allowed in the bleachers during the event.** If your team would like to arrange to rent a tent for the meet as teams have done in the past, please contact the facility as soon as possible so they can steer you in the correct direction.
5. **Only credentialed swimmers, coaches, volunteer meet workers, and officials will be allowed on deck in areas other than those designated for spectators.** Please help us in keeping spectators off the rail in front of the bleachers as it is required by the Fire Marshall. People not adhering to this rule will be warned once and then ejected from the facility.
6. **PARKING** - All parking will be in the lots to the north and south sides of the pool. No parking is allowed in the grass or on sidewalks. Cars doing so **will** be towed or ticketed.
7. Please note the **REQUIREMENT** for each team to **provide timers**. Your Team's timing assignments will be posted on the Meet Web page. This has worked very well over the years, and your continued cooperation in this regard will make the meet go smoothly. Thanks in advance.
8. USA Swimming teams—**WE NEED YOUR HELP WITH OFFICIALS FOR THE MEET.** If your team has officials, PLEASE ask them to come to the meet and help out. Any help we can get is greatly appreciated. Please have your Officials e-mail, Head Referee, Rick Sheridan (rsheridan@tampabay.rr.com), that they will be able to work the meet. As is custom with our team, Officials working three sessions or more will receive a gift of appreciation from CVST.
9. As you should know this meet is run as a USA Swimming Approved meet, which means that both USA Swimming and Non-USA Swimming swimmers compete. Times earned by USA swimmers are approved and accepted as official.
10. **Body Paint** on anyone entering the pool is prohibited, as are **artificial noise makers** anywhere in the Aquatic Complex.
