HAVE NO RESTRICTIONS.**

It is understood and agreed that USA Swimming, Florida Swimming and Saint Pete Aquatics shall be free from any liabilities or claims for damages arising by reason of injuries to anyone during the conduct of the meet

Deck Changing: Deck changing is NOT PERMITTED AT THE NORTH SHORE POOL.

Condition of Sanction: Any swimmer entered in the meet, must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water without the use of the backstroke ledge. When unaccompanied by a member coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, restrooms or locker rooms.

The City of Saint Petersburg and the FAA prohibit the flying of Drones in and around the North Shore Pool. Exceptions must be granted by the FAA and the City of Saint Petersburg.

The competition course has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2c(4). The copy of such certification is on file with USA Swimming.

All adults participating in or associated with this meet, acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that **they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct** of this competition.

TYPE OF MEET:	Outdoor, 25-yard, possible dual courses with maximum of 20 lanes 8 & Under, 10 & Under and 9-10 age groups – Timed Finals 500 Free, 400 IM, 1000 Free – Timed Finals ALL OF FRIDAY’S EVENTS WILL BE SWUM FASTEST TO SLOWEST Prelims: Normal Age Groups 11 & 12, 13 & 14, 15 & 16, Seniors. Finals will be conducted as Championship Finals ONLY for Top 10 qualifiers in each individual age: 11’s, 12’s, 13’s, 14’s, 15’s and 16 year olds. Seniors will swim Championship finals followed by Consolation Finals. Finals: In each event of the Finals session, the heats will be organized with the Championship Finals first and then the Consolation Finals in that order. Swimmers will be announced in the water. ALTERNATES: Alternates wishing to swim must report to the deck referee and be standing ready to swim at the starter stand by the start of the race. The fastest swimmer from the consolation heat will be moved into finals and an alternate into consolation finals.
DATE AND TIME:	Friday, July 24, 5:00 PM start – 3:30pm warmup – ALL EVENTS ON FRIDAY ONLY WILL BE FASTEST TO SLOWEST Saturday & Sunday, July 25 & 26 Morning 11 & older session, 8:00 AM start 6:30am warm-up 10 & Under Session – 35 minutes after conclusion of 11 & older morning session Finals Saturday & Sunday- Not before 3:00 PM (TBA at coaches meeting on Friday at 4:45 PM). Warm-up start 45 minutes before finals.
LOCATION:	North Shore Aquatic Complex 901 North Shore Drive St. Petersburg, FL 33701
POOL SPECS:	Certified, outdoor, 25-yard, 22 lane pool. Competition pool depth minimum of four feet at start and turn end, separate warm-up lanes. Maximum of two 10 lane courses with non-turbulent lane lines. Multiple lanes available for warm up and warm down during the meet.
TIMING & SCORING:	Colorado Time Systems with scoreboard, back-up hand held watches and Midnight Sports Scoring
WARM-UP:	Friday – 3:30 PM Saturday & Sunday Morning 11 & Older – 6:30-7:45 AM Saturday & Sunday 10 & Under – 30 minutes after the conclusion of the 11 & Older morning session (after Events 73/74 & Events 149/150) Saturday & Sunday Finals – 45 minutes before start time WARM-UP LANES WILL BE ASSIGNED AND POSTED No Equipment and feet first entry except when doing a racing start off of the block.
ELIGIBILITY:	Open to all currently registered USA swimmers in Area 3 only who have not achieved the current FLAGS or Senior Championship cuts in their age group events, no restriction for Senior Events.. Any swimmer entered with a faster than the appropriate time for that event will not be allowed to swim in that event. SENIOR EVENTS HAVE NO RESTRICTIONS.

SEEDING:	Short course, 25-yard times will be used for seeding. Conversion times and NO TIME ENTRIES are not permitted. Times will be seeded yard times first and then long course meter times.
SCRATCHES:	No penalty for scratches on the block during prelims WITH EXCEPTION OF DECK SEEDED EVENTS. Any swimmer entered in an individual event that is seeded at the meet, who has checked in for that event, must swim that event unless he/she notifies the Clerk of Course before the seeding of that event has begun if he/she wishes to scratch. Failure to do so will result in his/her barred from their next individual event in which he/she is entered on that day or the next day, whichever comes first. FINALS: Any swimmer qualifying for a consolation final or a championship final race who fails to compete in said race shall be barred from his/her next event unless: A) The referee is notified in the event of illness or injury and accepts proof thereof, or B) A swimmer qualifying for a consolation final or championship final races based upon the results of the preliminaries notifies the Clerk of Course within 30 minutes following their last individual preliminary event. In the event of weather delays, the meet committee may suspend any or all penalties.
ENTRY LIMIT:	All swimmers will be limited to three (3) individual events per day plus relays. Swimmers posting entries over the entry limit will be as entered in the first three (3) events. No limit on relay entries, but each team should designate relay "A", "B", "C", etc.
DECK ENTRIES:	Deck entries will be accepted FOR SWIMMERS ALREADY IN THE MEET by the referee in timed finals or prelim events, including relays from swimmers already entered in the meet, provided that no new heats are created; that the swimmer does not exceed the permitted number of events, and the swimmer does not exceed the cut off times. A swimmer may not scratch or fail to appear in an event in order to deck enter another event. The fee is \$10.00 per individual and \$10.00 per relay event, made payable immediately. Any deck seeded entries must be approved by the referee a minimum of 45 minutes before the start of that session.

ENTRY DEADLINE:	All entries must be received by 6:00 PM on July, 16, 2026. NO FAX ENTRIES ACCEPTED. Email to swimstpete@aol.com .		
Disability Athletes:	Coaches entering swimmers with disabilities that require any accommodations or modifications, including the need for personal assistants and/or registered service animals must provide advanced notice in writing, accompanying their meet entry file, to the meet referee by the entry deadline. Failure to provide advanced notice may limit the Host's ability to accommodate all requests.

RULES:	Current USA Swimming Technical Rules will govern the meet. Safety rules, as outlined by USA Swimming and as recommended by the Head Marshall, will be in effect during all warm-up periods and in all warm-up areas. The USA Swimming “no recall” start will be used as outlined in 102.12.4H.		
STARTS:	The “ fly-over or immediate climb out start ” may be used at the discretion of the head referee for any or all of the events in the meet.		
TEAM REP:	Prior to the start of the meet, each team may give the name of one other person other than the coach to the meet referee. The meet referee will recognize only the coach and the person so designated as the representative of the team. Prior to the start of the meet, all teams must present a list of current USA Swimming certified coaches attending the meet and representing their team. Unattached coaches not entering any swimmers in the meet (not the coach of record designated by the team) will not have deck access.		
Identifications:	Coaches and Officials must register with Meet Referee or their Designate. Prove current USA Swimming membership and sign the Florida Swimming Meet Sign-in sheet, receive a wrist band to be on the pool deck. Coaches can use Deck Pass as proof of membership.

CAMERA ZONES:	Still and video photography will be allowed from the bleacher area only EXCEPT DURING THE START OF THE 25 YARD EVENTS, NO PHOTOGRAPHY FROM BEHIND THE STARTING BLOCKS AT ANY TIME. During the start of the 25 yard events, all cell phones and cameras will be put away or the meet will stop till they are. Cameras are not permitted on the pool deck or in the locker room areas. THIS MEANS NO PHOTOGRAPHY FROM THE POOL DECK AT ANY TIME FOR ANY REASON.		
DISTANCE CHECK IN:	All coaches must check in their swimmers for the 500 Freestyle by 4:00PM, the 400 IM by 4:30 PM on Friday, the 1000 Freestyle by 8:30 AM on Saturday, the 1650 by 8:30am on Sunday Swimmers missing check-in for any deck seeded event may swim in an empty lane. NO NEW HEATS WILL BE CREATED.
